

Foothill Green Pool Board Meeting 7/20/2011

1. Report from splash on any pool issue
  - (a) Pool closing at thunder
    - i. The guards cannot see lightning from the foothills from their vantage point. If thunder is heard nearby – or they see lightning, the guards will clear the pool. During storms members are asked to leave the pool area. In cases of severe weather (hail, lightning storms, etc) members may wait in the bathrooms (not the office or entry way) until it is safe to go home or return to the pool. Guards will make available the office phone so that unattended children may call for a ride home.
    - ii. 'Thunder Rule' – When hear thunder within 30 seconds of seeing a lightning strike they will clear the pool.
    - iii. The lightning policy is posted on the office window facing the pool
  - (b) Extending late night swim hours
    - i. The guards expressed concerns with 10 p.m. closing time on Thursday night. At 10 p.m. it's too dark to safely supervise the pool and see all member (not enough lighting). The board will consider creating two late night swim nights next year, but close at 9:00 p.m.
  - (c) Website
    - i. Members and guards said that the web site needs work and updating. Conveniently. This happened to be an agenda item on this meeting and Steve had a new 'demo' site for the board.
2. Neighborhood night out August 2.
  - (a) The FGP received a \$200 grant from the City of Fort Collins for Neighborhood Night Out. The grant will cover three guards as a private party. Neighborhood Night Out is August 2nd.
  - (b) The event is an open open to all neighbors.
  - (c) Participants should bring a side dish to share and place settings for their family.
  - (d) The Board will provide hotdogs and beverages.
  - (e) Steve will make and print fliers. He will place these in the office when ready for distribution.
